

Parents who pick up their children should please do so promptly. It is better to plan and be in School 15 minutes before closing time than be late.

❖ **SECURITY CONSCIOUSNESS:**

Where a different person other than the parent or whoever has been coming to school to pick up a child is arranged to pick up the child, the School authority must have been duly informed earlier. The school will not release any child to anyone who is not known to or registered with the School for that purpose.
